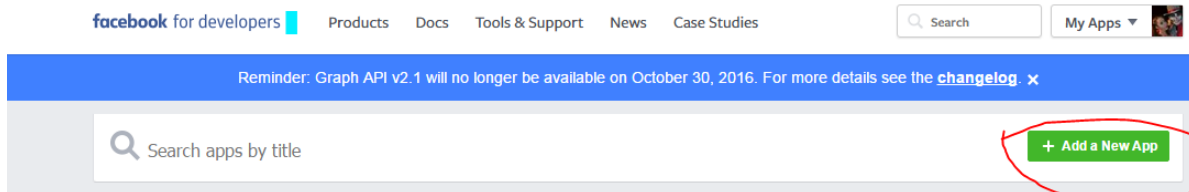


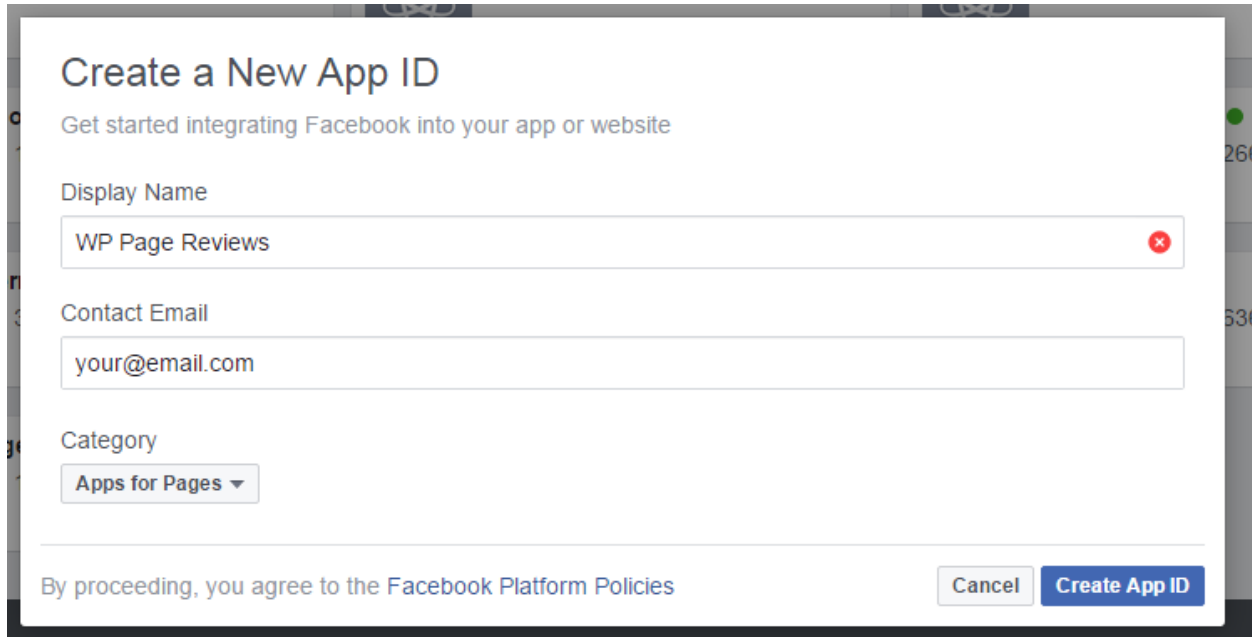

Create Facebook App Instructions

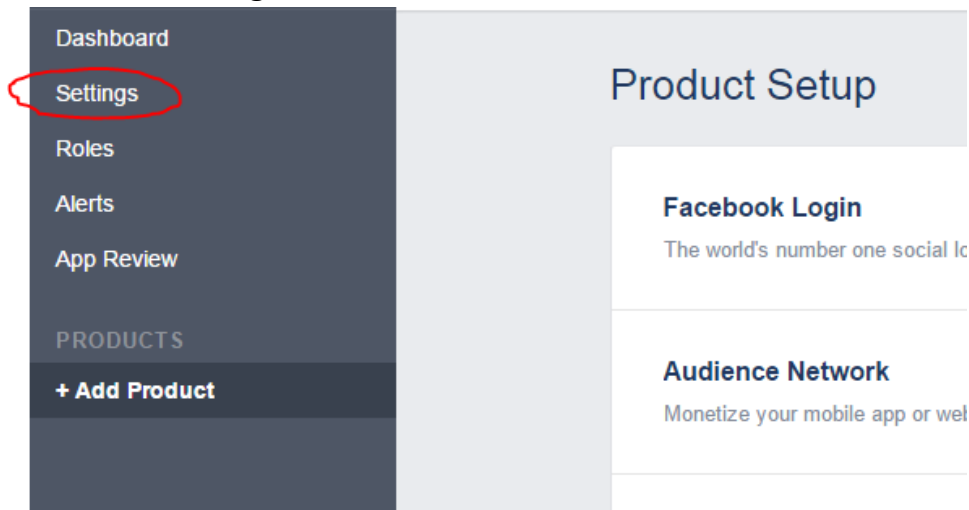
1. Go to <https://developers.facebook.com/apps> and click the “Add a New App” button.



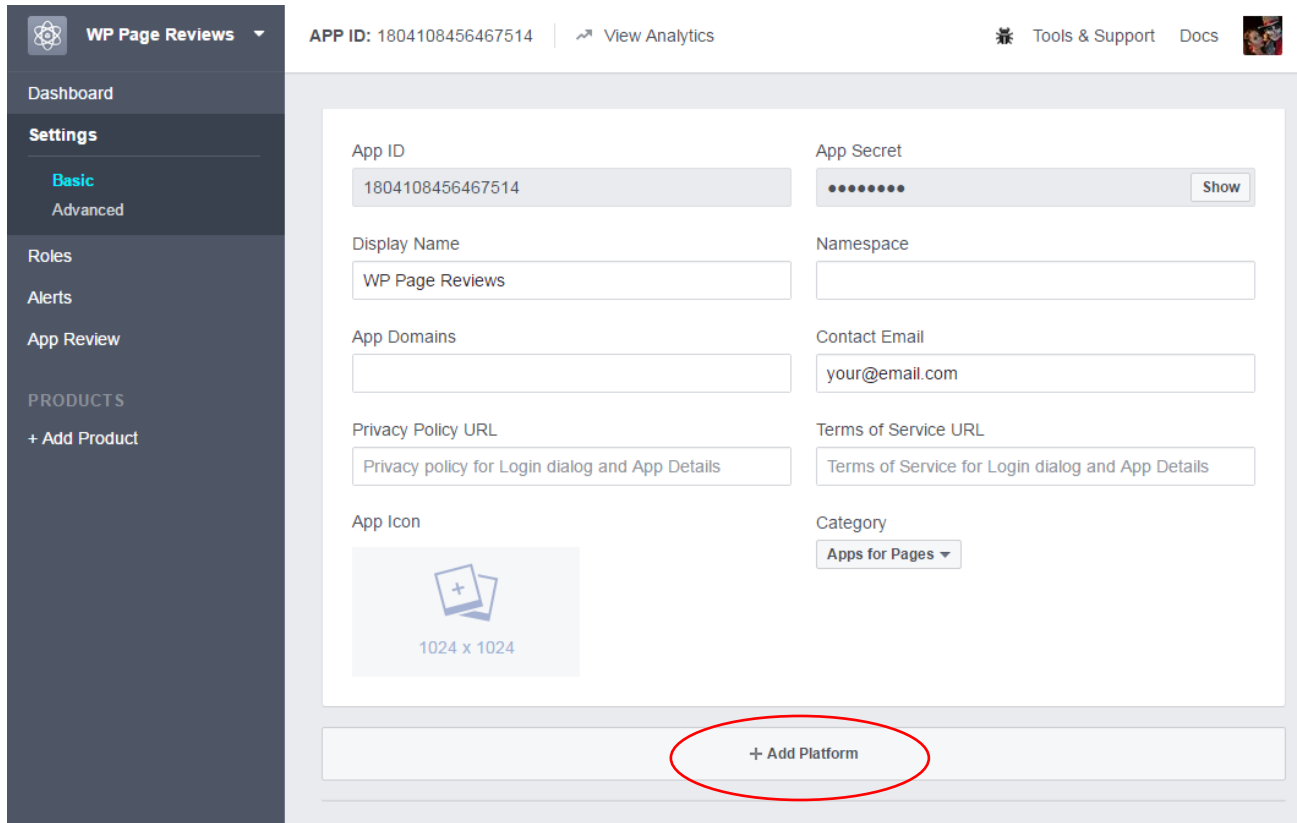
2. Enter a Display Name, your contact email, and set the Category to “Apps for Pages”.



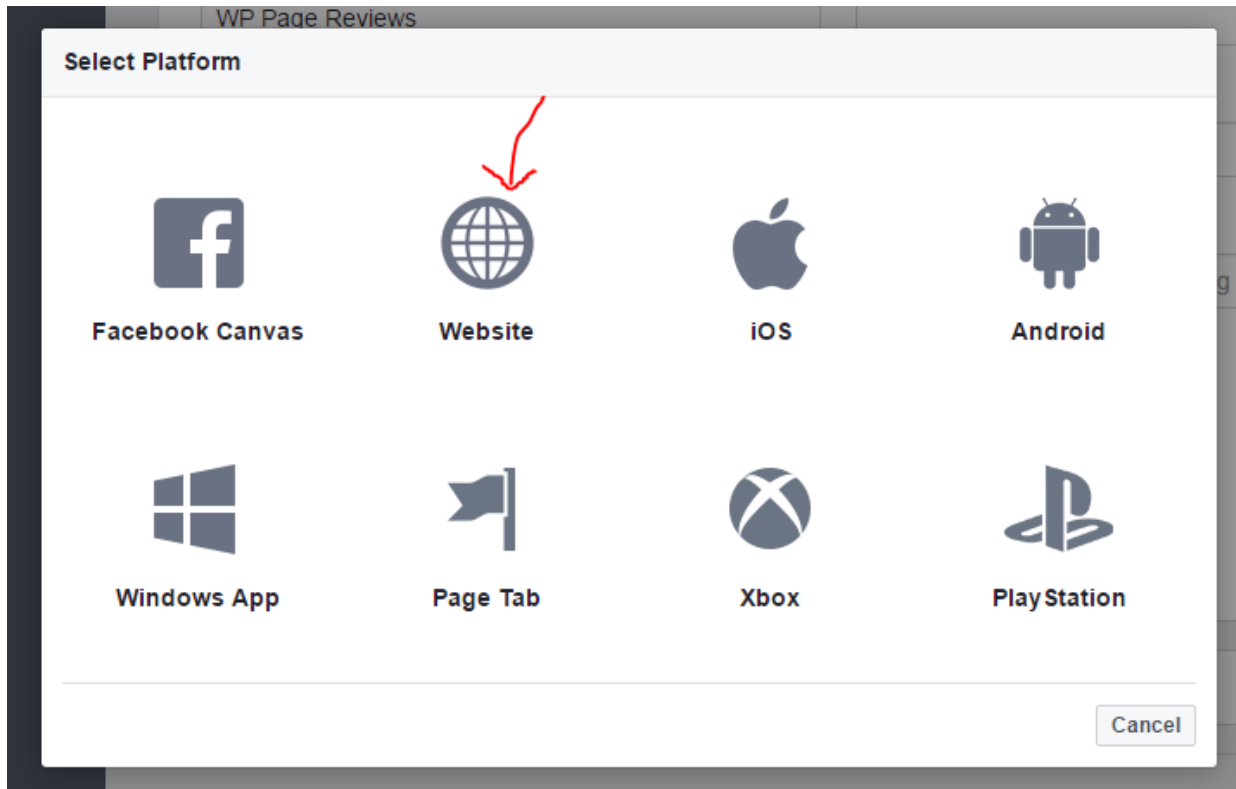
3. Click the "Create App ID" then fill in the Security Check captcha and click submit.

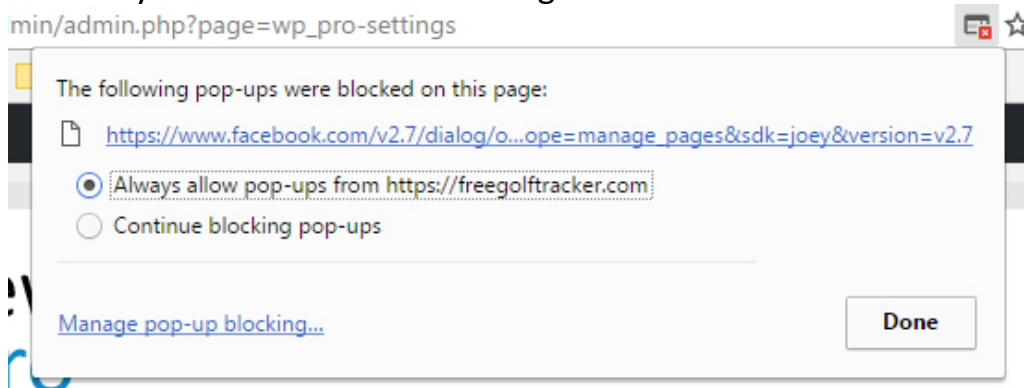

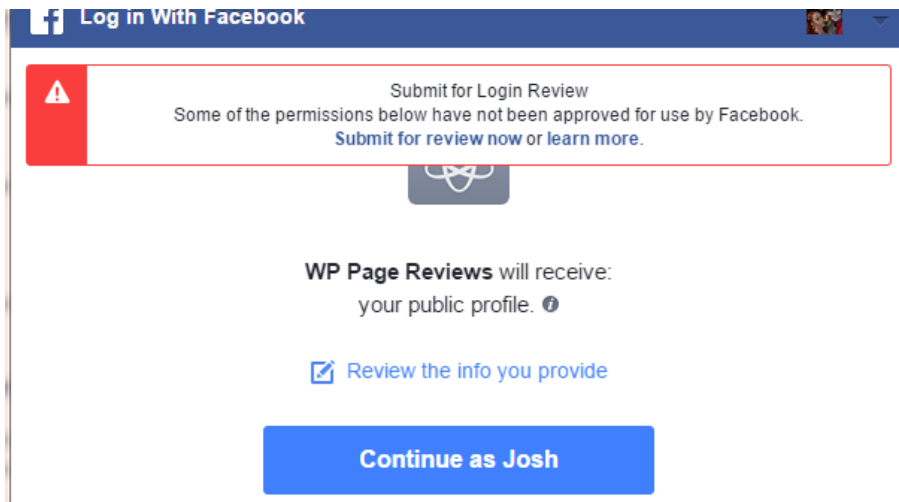
