Favourite, long lasting cut flower with spicy scent. Blooms in summer. Stems are easily broken and may require staking. Freeze seeds 5 to 10 days before sowing. Cover seed. Excellent cut flower, and good for drying.

Compact 30 cm (12") plants with fragrant flowers in shades of scarlet, crimson, white, rose, pink and striped.

Flax - Dainty flowers open to the sun but close at night or on dull days. Does well in poor soil. Seed needs light to germinate. Requires regular watering. Compact plant, Blooms June to frost,

A rainbow of colours. Purple, red, orange, pink, yellow and white shades and some bi-colours. Blooms late spring to mid-summer.
