

Asparagus Martha Washington		This early variety produces large, thick spears. The heads are tight with a hint of purple on the tip. Rust resistant. Excellent for home or market gardens. Roots require 2 to 3 years to establish before harvesting spears. Approximate Seeds Per Gram - 43. Seeding Rate - 30 grams per 100 ft row or 2kg per acre.

Famous for flavour and yield over long seasons. Valuable crop for freezing, canning and home gardens. Seeds white; resistant to Common Bean Mosaic virus. Slow fibre and seed development. Approximate Seeds Per Gram - 3 to 4. Seeding Rate - 700 to 900 grams per 100 ft row, or 25 to 40 kg per acre.

Heavy yielder is resistant to CBM 1. Seeds are white; great as shell beans. Approximate Seeds Per Gram-1-4. Seeding Rate - 300 to 500 grams per 100 ft row, or 25 kg per acre.

Heavy yielding, stringless. Seeds white with brown eye. Approximate Seeds Per Gram - 3 to 4. Seeding Rate - 700 to 900 grams per 100 ft row, or 25 to 40 kg per acre.

Heavy yielder, excellent for freezing. Seeds black - tolerates cooler soil for germination. Approximate Seeds Per Gram - 3 to 4. Seeding Rate - 700 to 900 grams per 100 ft row, or 25 to 40 kg per acre.

Pods turn deep green after 2 min. of boiling to indicate blanching. Resistant to Common Bean Mosaic, NY15 Virus and Pod Mottle. Tolerant to Curly Top Virus. Seeds buff. Approximate Seeds Per Gram - 3 to 4. Seeding Rate - 700 to 900 grams per 100 ft row, or 25 to 40 kg per acre.

Because of attractive scarlet flowers, it is also used as an ornamental climber. Seeds dark purple mottled with violet. Very attractive to hummingbirds. Approximate Seeds Per Gram: 1 - 4. Seeding Rate - 300 to 500 grams per 100 ft row, or 25 kg per acre.

Pods are brittle and absolutely stringless even when fully mature. A classic variety primarily for home garden use. Rapid seed development. Seeds coffee brown. Approximate Seeds Per Gram - 3 to 4. Seeding Rate - 700 to 900 grams per 100 ft row, or 25 to 40 kg per acre.

Seeding Rate - 700 to 900 grams per 100 ft row, or 25 to 40 kg per acre.












<b>Beet</b> <b>Detroit Dark Red</b>		56 days. Globe shaped, dark red smooth exterior. Interior is a uniform dark red with indistinct zoning and finely grained. Tops 30-40 cm (12-15") tall, glossy dark green tinged with maroon. Good storage properties. Excellent main crop beet. Approximate Seeds Per Gram - 70. Seeding Rate - 30 to 60 grams per 100 ft row, or 6 kg per acre.	<b>Packet</b> <b>\$1.25</b>	<b>28 gr</b> <b>\$3.50</b>
<b>Beet</b> <b>Early Wonder</b>		50 days. Flattened globe with rounded shoulders and small tap root. Smooth exterior, dark red, 8 cm (3") in diameter. Interior dark red with some lighter red zoning. Tops 40-45 cm (15-18") tall, large and uniformly erect green leaves. A very early sweet and tender bunching variety. The fast growing tops are always in demand for greens. <b>Beet</b> <b>Formanova (Cylindra)</b>		55 days. A high quality cylindrical beet for slicing. Carrot shaped roots are 15 cm (6") long by 5-8 cm (2-3") in diameter, providing up to 4 times the number of uniform slices than other beets. Deep red colour, and fine texture. Excellent for commercial canneries and home gardeners. Approximate Seeds Per Gram - 70. <b>Beet</b> <b>Ruby Queen</b>		50 days. A very dark red interior, free from zoning. Very attractive short dark green tops, turning to red and fine tap root ideal for bunching. <b>Broccoli</b> <b>Green Sprouting Celebrese</b>		55 days from transplant. An early variety, very popular with market gardeners, canneries and freezers. Plants are deep green, 45-50 cm (18-20") tall. <b>Brussels Sprouts</b> <b>Long Island Improved</b>		90 days. <b>Cabbage</b> <b>Chinese (Chi-Hi-Li) (early)</b>		75 days. Early, sure-heading variety. The heads are oblong, 7-10 cm (3-4") thick and 45-50 cm (17-19") tall, tapering at the top. This vigorous cabbage has a well blanched heart with bright green outer leaves. Very tender, excellent quality with a celery like spicy taste. Approximate Seeds Per Gram - 210. <b>Cabbage</b> <b>Copenhagen Market</b>		68 days from transplant. Plants 30-35 cm (11-14") tall, erect, compact, short stemmed. Outer leaves sparse, medium green and cup shaped. Heads 15-18 cm (6-7"), weighing 1.5 kg (3-4 lbs). Globe shaped and solid. An early market and home garden type. Approximate Seeds Per Gram - 210. <b>Cabbage</b> <b>Danish Ballhead</b>		100 days from transplant. Plants 30-45 cm (12-16") tall, short stemmed, medium large with blue-green colour. A good storage cabbage and make fine quality kraut. Approximate Seeds Per Gram - 210. 

<b>Cabbage</b> <b>Savoy Perfection</b>		85 - 90 days from transplant. Heads are flattened globe shape, 18 x 25 cm (7 x 10"). Approximate weight 3 kg (6 lbs). Leaves closely crimped or savoyed, and hold green colour when cooked. Savoy cabbage is commonly regarded as the best tasting of all types of cabbage. Stands a long time without bursting. Approximate Seeds Per Gram - 210. Seeding Rate - 15 grams per 100 ft row, or 0.5 kg per acre.	<b>Packet</b> <b>\$1.35</b>	<b>28 gr</b> <b>\$3.50</b>
<b>Cantaloupe</b> <b>Hales Best 45 (early)</b>		85 days. 16 x 14.5 cm (6.5 x 5.75") oval shaped fruits with moderate ribbing and heavy netting. Flesh is salmon orange, thick and sweet. Resistant to powdery mildew. Approximate Seeds Per Gram - 43. Seeding Rate - 30 grams per 100 ft row, or 1.4 kg per kg.	<b>Packet</b> <b>\$1.35</b>	<b>14 gr</b> <b>\$3.30</b>
<b>Carrot</b> <b>Chantenay Red</b>		70 days. Tops 38-50 cm (15 - 20"), strong crowns. Roots 15 x 6 cm (6 x 2.5"), heavy bodied, tapering to a blunt point. Solid, deep orange. Produces heavy tonnage. Strong crowns make this carrot excellent for winter storage and freezing, and popular for juicing and canning. Approximate Seeds Per Gram - 800. <b>Carrot</b> <b>Danvers Half Long</b>		68 days. Roots 18 x 5 cm (7 x 2"), tapering to semi-blunt end. Medium orange colour. Tops good 40-50 cm (16-20") tall. Leading main crop variety, suitable for home garden, processing, freezing and canning. Outstanding in heavier soils. Approximate Seeds Per Gram - 800. Seeding Rate - 15 to 20 grams per 100 ft row, or 1.4 kg per acre.	<b>Packet</b> <b>\$1.25</b>	<b>28 gr</b> <b>\$2.60</b>
<b>Carrot</b> <b>Healthmaster Hybrid</b>		100 - 130 days. This is a big carrot! In some growing conditions, it can grow to 25 cm (10") in length and weigh as much as 700 g (1.5 lb). This hybrid was developed to produce 1/3 more Vitamin A than open pollinated varieties like Danvers. Perfect for slicing and juicing. Healthmaster should be allowed to mature fully for best taste and highest quality. Approximate Seeds Per Gram - 800. Leading market and shipping variety, and well suited to winter storage. Requires deep loamy soil. Approximate Seeds Per Gram - 800.
