This is to certify that we the undersigned do will our property as follows. That Henry Geza is to have the land all but the house and garden is to be ours so long as we live, and the horses all but Jim Colt, and all the cattle but one cow is to be kept for our use and we are to have eight dollars from the butter for clothing each year and the remainder for our use one calf to be raised each year so that we can have a two yearling to sell each year and eight sheep but we are to have two sheep kept as our own and two lambs to sell each year, and one fat pig of 200 lbs or more to be kept for us each year, and half the eggs. We are to live together and be properly taken care of. One team of horses, ten head of cattle and eight sheep must be kept on the place so long as we live, and the implements also. We are to have the horses and rig to drive when we see fit to use them.
